
# Consulting in operational safety for water parks and swimming pools






#### The reason for this service: Compliance with regulations and up-to-date operation manuals

The international standards EN 1069 and ASTM F2376, related to safety in the design, manufacture, installation, and <u>operation</u> of <u>facilities with water slides, establish that the operator of the establishment must have a set of associated technical documentation and keep it properly updated.</u>

Similarly, it is also necessary to have <u>operation manuals and</u>
<u>lifeguard protocols</u> so that all staff members share common guidelines and know how to act in the event of any incident. This is especially important for establishments that outsource their lifeguard teams.



## The reason for this service: legal protection against possible incidents

There is a significant gap in these areas, leaving many management companies without <u>adequate</u> documentation protection in the event of accidents or <u>incidents</u> that may occur, especially in establishments that outsource their lifeguard teams.

For all these reasons, we are launching this new consulting service for the preparation and proper management of documentation and operational safety for water parks and recreational pools.

And all of this under two work modalities that adapt to the specific needs of each establishment.

### Online consulting for the analysis and development of documentation



#### Modality 1 – Online consulting

We propose an online consulting service through which we prepare the following documentation:

#### At the level <u>of technical document management</u> of the facility:

- 1. Risk analysis document for each aquatic attraction (parameters according to the applicable standard)
- 2. Maintenance instructions
- 3. Documentation for recording maintenance work, repairs, and modifications of the equipment
- 4. Support in the creation of safety signage\\* for the general usability of the facilities (parameters according to the applicable standard).

#### At the level of operation and lifeguard protocols:

- 1. Lifeguard onboarding and orientation guide
- 2. General procedures manual for lifeguard management in aquatic facilities
- 3. Record documentation (water rescues, general incidents, operation of each attraction, first aid kit supply control, Continuous Evaluation Record of lifeguards)
- 4. Generic operational safety documentation (water rescue and first aid reports, general incident logs)



## Option 2 – On-site auditing and consulting for the development of the work

Beyond the preparation of all the documents included in the previous case, we offer the option to expand the service and carry out a project with on-site implementation at the establishment, consisting of three phases:

- 1. Conducting a safety audit to identify risks and perform on-site evaluations of lifeguards.
- 2. Thorough review of existing protocols and documentation related to aquatic operational safety.
- 3. Development and implementation of new, comprehensive operations manuals, refined through meetings with the company's professionals.
